Tea ceremony workshop for child and parent

The Japanese Way of Tea brings the principles of appreciation and respect toward each other into the parent-child relation. This short version of workshop will review the basic practice of serving and being served in the Japanese Way of Tea setting. The workshop will begin with a demonstration of tea service where the participants play the role of guests. Then the children will make tea for their parents, following step-by-step instruction of the sensei.

The participants are encouraged to ask questions about the history, culture, refinement and tradition of the classical Japanese tea ceremony.
